

Kingsford to Centennial Park Walking and Cycling Improvements

Upcoming work in October

We are continuing the construction work along the project alignment to build the new cycleway.

We are nearing the completion of Sections 1 and 2 of the cycleway. We will provide more information in the coming weeks.

Upcoming work – standard hours

Our standard construction hours are Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 7.30am to 3.30pm.

Our work is dependant on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

- Continue landscaping and final concrete work along Doncaster Avenue between Alison Road and Anzac Parade – **up to five days of work**
- Installation of street furniture including signage – **up to five days of work**.

Upcoming work – out of hours

We will complete most of the work during the day, however, to maintain safety for road users and workers, and to keep people moving on local roads, we need to carry out some of our work outside normal construction hours.

Upcoming out of hours activity includes:

- Line marking on Doncaster Avenue between Alison Road and Day Avenue and on Houston Road between Day Avenue and Barker Street – **up to ten nights of work**

We may work up to five shifts a week and will provide two nights of respite in each week.

Out of hours work will be between 7pm and 5am, and the noisiest works will finish at midnight.

Minimising community impact

Our work activities will require the use of machinery that generates noise and vibration. Equipment used for these activities include saw-cutter, excavator, concrete truck, compaction equipment, vacuum truck, excavators and hand and power tools.

If work is required out of hours, we will also use mobile lighting towers.

To minimise the impact of this work we will:

- monitor noise periodically so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work as required
- fit equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly non-tonal reversing beepers.

In addition, at night we will also:

- complete the noisiest activities such as saw-cutting and jackhammering by midnight
- direct temporary lighting down and away from houses
- turn off machinery when not in use
- use noise blankets to minimise noise, where feasible.

We will work with residents near this work to minimise impacts and all work will be carried out in line with project environmental approvals.

There may be some parking removal associated with these works. Residents will be notified in advance

Traffic and pedestrian path changes

There will be temporary lane closures to ensure the safety of road users and workers and temporary changes to parking.

There may be partial footpath closures near our work area and alternative path and signs will be in place.

We may also have detours in place for some of our work. Properties affected by these detours will be notified directly.

Other work nearby

Randwick City Council have made changes to the cycleway design at the Ascot Street and Doncaster Avenue intersection.

These changes will improve safety and access at the intersection.

Council have appointed KK Civil Construction to complete this work.

They will be working from mid-October for approximately one month, weather permitting. This work will be completed during the day.
