Upcoming work

Starting from **Monday 3 July**, we will be working up to 10 days to build a new raised pedestrian crossing along Doncaster Avenue at Darling Street, Kensington.

During this work, Doncaster Avenue will be temporarily closed between Darling Street and Anzac Parade, including the Darling Street intersection. A detour will be in place to ensure the safety of road users, pedestrians and workers.

The map overleaf shows the road closure locations and planned detour route.

Work hours

Our standard work hours are between **7am** and **6pm**, Monday to Friday.

Work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Minimising community impact

Our work activities will require the use of machinery that generates noise and vibration. Equipment used for these activities include sawcutter, excavator, concrete truck, compaction equipment, vacuum truck and excavators.

To minimise the impact of this work we will:

- monitor noise periodically so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work as required
- fit equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly non-tonal reversing beepers
- turn off machinery when not in use

We will work with residents near these works to minimise impacts. All work will be carried out in line with project environmental approvals.
