Kingsford to Centennial Park Walking and Cycling Improvements

Upcoming work and out of hours work

Transport for NSW | August – September 2023

We are continuing the construction along the project alignment to build the new cycleway connecting Kingsford to Centennial Park.

Upcoming work – standard hours

Our standard construction hours are Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 7.30am to 3.30pm. Work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Work will continue along the routes as shown in in the map overleaf.

- Commencement of pavement work and landscape upgrades on Houston Road from Day Avenue to Barker Street – **up to 20 days of work**
- Continued pavement and kerbing work, and landscape upgrades on Doncaster Avenue between Bowral Street and Anzac Parade – **up to 20 days of work**
- Concrete pavement and kerbing work, and landscape upgrades on Doncaster Avenue between Abbotford Street and Bowral Street – **up to 20 days of work**
- Landscaping on Doncaster Avenue between Anzac Parade and Day Avenue – **up to 20 days of work**
- Landscaping on Day Avenue between Doncaster Avenue and Houston Road – **up to 20 days of work**

Upcoming work – out-of-hours

Most work will be completed during the day, however, to maintain safety for road users and workers, and to keep people moving on local roads, we need to carry out some of our work outside normal construction hours.

Directly impacted residents from the work below will be notified in advance, where applicable

Upcoming out of hours activity includes:

Over the coming months we will be completing work along:

- Doncaster Avenue between Abbotford Street to Day Avenue,
- Day Avenue between Doncaster Avenue and Houston Road
- Houston Road between Day Avenue and Barker Street

The out of hours work includes:

- Line marking – **up to 10 nights of work**
- Continue road resheeting – **up to 15 nights of work**
- Continue traffic lane changes – **up to four nights of work**

We will also be installing concrete median islands on Day Avenue (between Doncaster Avenue and Houston Road) and on Houston Road (between Day Avenue and Barker Street) – **up to 10 nights of work**

This work will occur **up to five nights a week between 7pm and 5am** and will provide two nights of respite in each week. Our work is dependent on weather and site conditions, and we do not work public holidays.

Minimising community impact

Our work activities will require the use of machinery that generates noise and vibration. Equipment used for these activities include saw-cutter, excavator, concrete truck, compaction equipment, vacuum truck, excavators and hand and power tools.

If work is required out-of-hours, we will also use mobile lighting towers.

To minimise the impact of this work we will:

- Complete noisiest work activities such as saw cutting and jackhammering by midnight
- Monitor noise periodically so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work as required
- Fit equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly non-tonal reversing beepers.

In addition, at night we will also:

- direct temporary lighting set ups down and away from windows into homes
- turn off machinery when not in use where possible
- use noise blankets to minimise noise, where feasible.

We will work with residents near this work to minimise impacts and all work will be carried out in line with project environmental approvals.

There may be some parking removal associated with these works. Residents will be notified in advance.

Site compounds

Site compounds were established in 2022 and will continue to be used throughout the project for the storage of materials and equipment, site offices and work amenities.

Our site compound may be used during our standard and out of hours work and plant and machinery may be in operation during this time.

Currently, our compound is located on Bass Street at the intersection of Anzac Parade.

Traffic and pedestrian path changes

There will be temporary lane closures to ensure the safety of road users and workers and temporary changes to parking.

There may be partial footpath closures near our work area and alternative path and signs will be in place.

We may also have detours in place for some of our work. Properties affected by these detours will be notified directly.
