The intersection of Lane Cove Road and Waterloo Road at Macquarie Park is being upgraded.



Upcoming works

Work from April to June 2023 includes:

- exploring and moving gas, water, electricity, telecommunications and underground services on all sides of the Lane Cove Road and Waterloo Road intersection. During this work we will sawcut and jack hammer to dig up the road.
- constructing a new retaining wall and re-aligning the boundaries of the work site and surrounding properties North-east of the Lane Cove Road and Waterloo Road intersection.
- digging up part of the footpath and road on the North-east side of the Lane Cove Road and Waterloo Road intersection as we upgrade existing footpaths and driveways to support construction work.

Our work schedule

From **Sunday 2 April** to **Friday 30 June** we will work up to **five night shifts** each week. Our night work hours are **8pm to 5am**.

You may notice deliveries and other minor works taking place at our site on the western end of Waterloo Road. Our day work hours are between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and between **8am and 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

There will be no work on public holidays.

Traffic changes

Temporary lane closures and footpath detours will be in place at times at the intersection of Waterloo Road and Lane Cove Road.

Traffic controllers and signs will be in place to help guide pedestrians and motorists through the area. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Travel times may be affected, so we thank you in advance for your patience during this important work.
