
Road surface and traffic improvements on Lawrence Hargrave Drive at Thirroul

Transport for NSW is improving traffic efficiency and safety on Lawrence Hargrave Drive at Thirroul from Monday 5 June, weather permitting

In response to concerns raised by local community members about the condition of the road, Transport will carry out road surface improvements, starting with resheeting work between Lachlan Street and Hewitts Avenue. Asphalt patching will follow from Bulli Pass to Phillip Street.

Work will take place under traffic over five nights between 8pm and 4am, weather permitting, with anticipated delays of up to five minutes.

As part of the asphalt work, we will relocate the southbound bus stop near High Street, install right turn bays into High Street and Wrexham Road, relocate two southbound parking spaces to increase northbound parking by five additional spaces, and repair and resurface the road. Two 'no stopping' signs have also recently been installed at the local access road.

Work to relocate the bus stop will be carried out mid-June, between 8pm and 4am, weather permitting.

This project will be carried out in stages. The community will be kept informed as the project progresses but all work is expected to be completed by late June 2023.

How will this work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise for residents.

Traffic impacts

A reduced speed limit of 40 km/h and a single lane closure will be in place during work. Residents will have access to their properties at all times.

Transport customers are advised to follow the direction of traffic control and allow up to five minutes additional travel time.
