

Linden Street upgrade

Project update | July - September 2023



The Linden Street upgrade is nearing completion, and once complete will reduce congestion and improve safety, traffic flow and journey reliability.

The project has experienced significant progress, including opening the in-lane bus stop on Linden Street, removing the eastbound through movement at The Grand Parade, opening the new roundabout at the intersection of Leonay and Oakwood Street, and adding right-turn arrows to the Leonay Street traffic lights. The project is on track for completion by September 2023.

What's happening?

From July to September, our work will include:

- Completing traffic signal work and the final electrical relocation at The Grand Parade
- Building new median islands at River Road, Linden Street and The Grand Parade
- Installing median drainage and pavement repairs on Linden Street, between River Road and Leonay Street
- Pavement repairs on the northbound lanes between Leonay Street and The Grand Parade
- Building the remaining footpaths and kerb ramps
- Placing the final pavement layers and line-marking
- Finishing works, including signage installation and landscaping.

How will the work impact me?

This work may be disruptive and noisy at times. Equipment used may include lights, vehicles and trucks, generators, excavators, vacuum trucks and water carts, powered hand tools and lighting towers.

We will make every effort to minimise disruption by:

- Fitting equipment with devices to minimise noise, including reversing squawkers rather than beepers
- Using noise shields
- Turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- Directing temporary lighting away from homes
- Carrying out noisier activities, including jackhammering and saw cutting, earlier in the night, where possible
- Monitoring noise to manage impacts and adjust our work, where possible.

Traffic and pedestrian changes

Traffic changes may include reduced speed limits, temporary lane and shoulder closures, intermittent stop/slow traffic control and detours. Local road closures will be advertised in advance on electronic message boards. Please observe traffic signs and traffic controllers' directions.

The new dedicated left turn lane between River Road and Leonay Street is now complete. We will use this lane between 9am-4pm and during night work to safely carry out finishing work. Outside of these times and on weekends, road users will be able to use this dedicated lane to turn left into Leonay Street, in addition to the two southbound through lanes.

A pedestrian detour remains in place until the new Galga Street cul-de-sac is built. Pedestrians can use the existing signalised crossings and footpaths on Linden Street, Leonay Street and Oakwood Street to join the footpath on River Road. Signage is in place to guide pedestrians.

Intermittent pedestrian detours may be in place to allow sufficient time for concrete to set while new footpaths and kerb ramps are being built. We will make every effort to stage the work and provide suitable temporary detours, where possible.
