The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek and connect to Sydney's motorway network.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will start work to install a temporary roundabout at the intersection of Elizabeth Drive and Devonshire Road in Kemps Creek from **Monday 25 September 2023**. The work will include:

- establishing a temporary construction compound at Salisbury Avenue, Kemps Creek
- locating existing underground services
- using machinery to cut into the road
- forming and pouring concrete
- laying new pavement
- restoring the area when all pavement and other work is completed.

We will also build a raised concrete median from Devonshire Road to just west of Salisbury Avenue. This will mean you can no longer turn right into and out of Salisbury Avenue.

When and where we'll be working

We will establish the construction compound at the northern end of Salisbury Avenue, Kemps Creek between **7am to 6pm, Monday to**

Friday. We will also deliver materials to and from the construction compound during these hours.

We will start work on the southern side of the Elizabeth Drive and Devonshire Road intersection in Kemps Creek **from early October**.

This work needs to be carried out at night for the safety of our workers and road users and to minimise traffic disruption.

The work hours are from **8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday**. No work will take place on Friday and Saturday nights or public holidays. We will not work more than two nights in a row and three nights in a week, in the same location.

What equipment will be used?

During the work we may use excavators, concreting equipment, light and heavy vehicles, hand power tools, rollers, hand compaction tools, vacuum trucks, water carts, sweepers, milling machines, asphalt pavers, bobcats and lighting towers.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Lane closures and reduced speed limits
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- Noise from plant and equipment.



Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

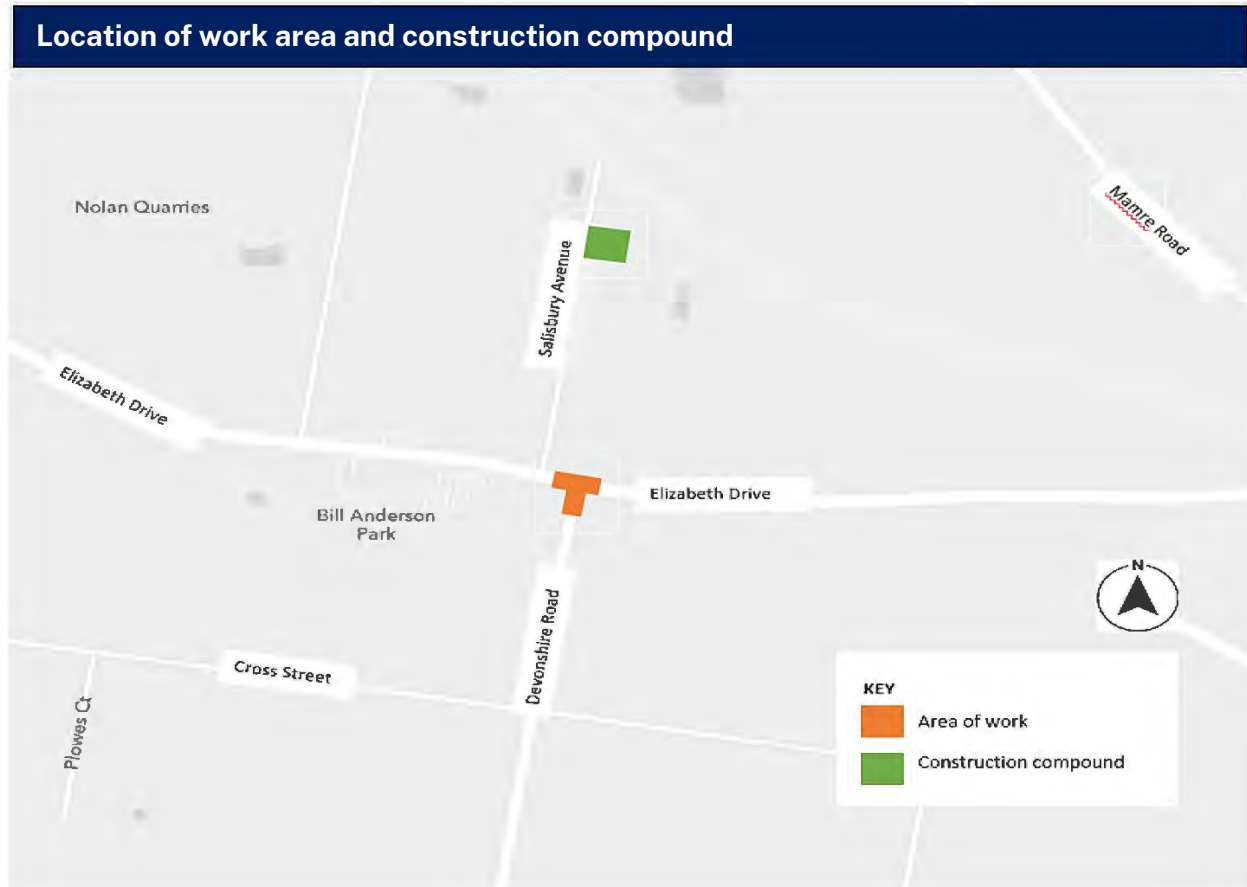
This includes:

- fencing the site compound and work area for safety and security
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- ensuring Salisbury Avenue is adequately maintained

- targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- monitoring noise so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work, where possible.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along the work zone during our work hours to ensure the work zone and traffic are safe while the equipment is used, delivered and removed.
