

Out of hours work for the installation of temporary roundabout in Kemps Creek

The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek and connect to Sydney's motorway network.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will continue night work for the installation of a temporary roundabout at the intersection of Elizabeth Drive and Devonshire Road in Kemps Creek until **Thursday 21 December 2023**.

During this period, we will:

- install concrete barriers and signage
- carry out line marking
- build concrete roundabout and raised median
- resurface the road pavement
- restore the area when all pavement and other work is complete.

When and where we'll be working

We will continue work at the intersection of Elizabeth Drive and Devonshire Road between **8pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday** until **Thursday 21 December 2023**. No work will take place on Friday and Saturday night or public holidays.

This work needs to be carried out at night for the safety of our workers and road users and to minimise traffic disruption.

We will continue to move vehicles and materials to and from the construction compound at the northern end of Salisbury Avenue between **8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday** and **7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday**.

Christmas shutdown: Our sites will be closed during the festive season from Friday 22 December 2022 and returning Monday 8 January 2023. If you notice any unusual activity or have any concerns about the site, please call us on 1800 577 441.

What equipment will be used?

During the work we may use excavators, concreting equipment, light and heavy vehicles, hand power tools, rollers, hand compaction tools, vacuum trucks, water carts, sweepers, milling machines, asphalt pavers, bobcats and lighting towers.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles in the area
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- pedestrian and cyclist detours with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- noise from plant and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

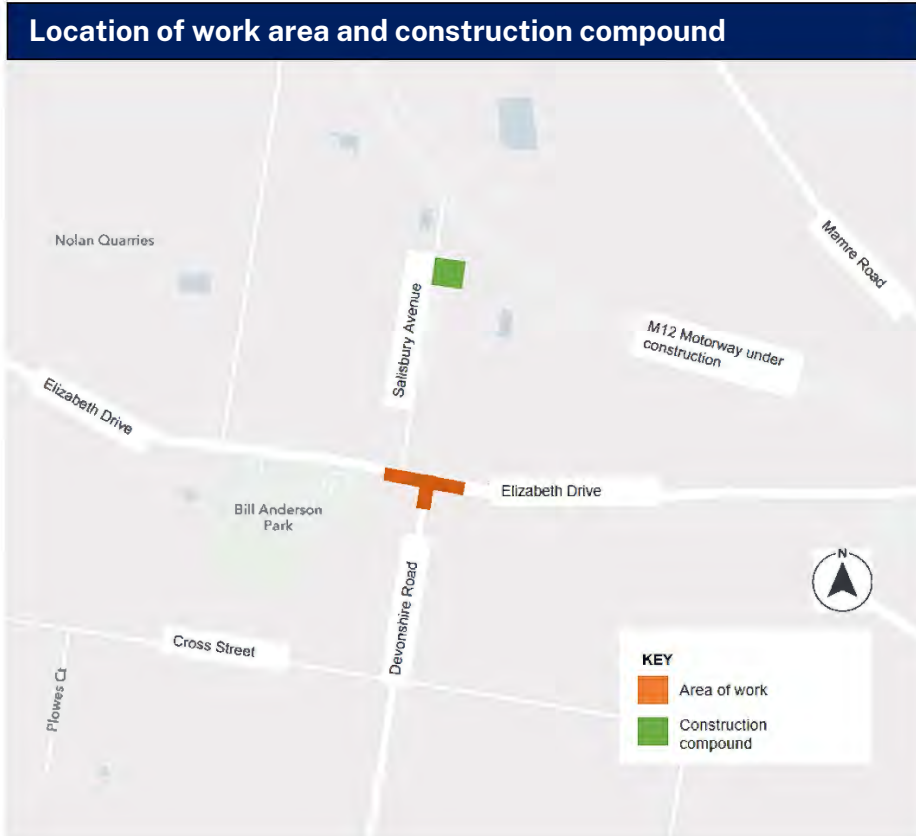


- carrying out high impact work before midnight where possible
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- ensuring Salisbury Avenue is adequately maintained
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- monitoring noise so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work where possible.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along the work zone during our work hours to ensure this area and traffic are safe.

The intersection of Elizabeth Drive and Devonshire Road will begin to operate as a roundabout from early to mid-December 2023. There will also be night time road closure on Devonshire Road during late November and mid-December 2023.
