



# M12 Motorway – West

## Out of hours work along Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek and Luddenham Road, Luddenham – March 2023

### What are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out early morning work over **38 morning shifts** between **Wednesday 22 February 2023** and **Tuesday 18 April 2023**, weather permitting. The work will take place within the project boundary along Elizabeth Drive north of the future airport access road. During this period, we will pour concrete foundation and paving.

Night work will also take place over **23 night shifts** between **Wednesday 1 March 2023** and **Friday 31 March 2023** along Elizabeth Drive, east of Luddenham Road in Badgerys Creek and Luddenham Road, Luddenham.

During this period, we will:

- repair, maintain and install road pavement, barriers, line marking, signage and road furniture as required
- deliver fill materials to the construction site on Elizabeth Drive
- install retaining wall panels on Elizabeth Drive
- pour concrete foundations and paving
- deliver, use and remove oversized equipment when needed.

These works need to be carried out at night for the safety of our workers and road users and to minimise traffic disruption.

We will also continue bridge works across Luddenham Road, Luddenham and Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek during the day. Traffic control will be in place during the works to manage the construction and road traffic across the construction intersection on Luddenham Road.

The map overleaf shows the locations of our work.

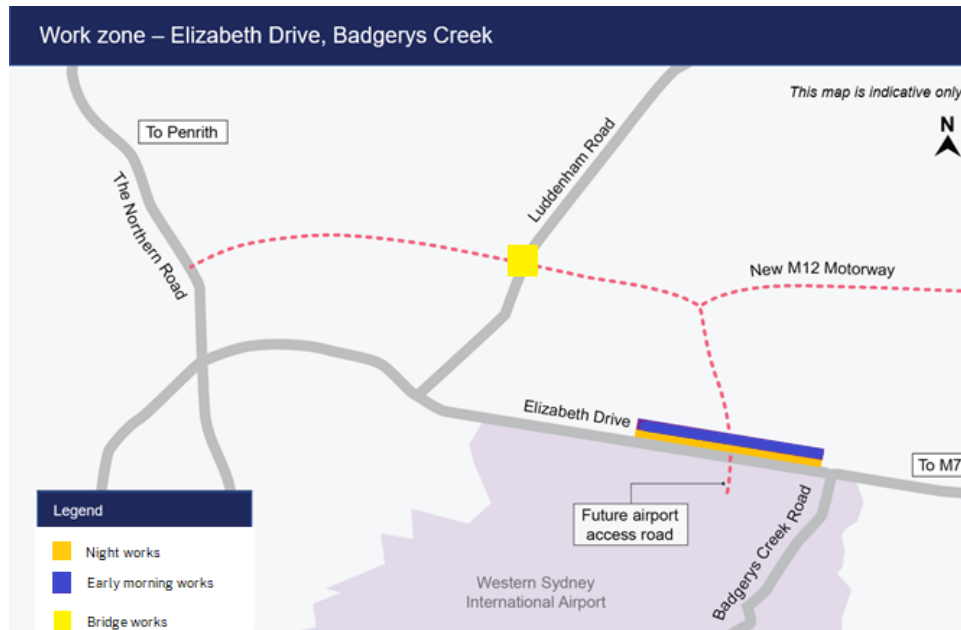
### Our work schedule

Our night work hours are between **6pm** and **7am**, Monday to Friday. Our early morning work will start from **4.30am** in addition to our day time work hours between **7am** and **6pm, Monday to Friday** and between **8am** and **6pm** on **Saturdays**. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.

### What equipment will be used?

During the early morning work, we will use concrete pump and light vehicles only. During the night work we may use excavators, compactors, light and heavy vehicles, hand powered tools, small cranes and wheeled excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete pumps, water carts, sweepers, milling machines and asphalt pavers, water blasters for line marking removal, and line marking trucks.

When we deliver the oversized equipment, we will use semi-trailer floats to deliver and remove it. When we work at night and on the road, we will use lighting towers and have traffic control in place.



## How will this work affect you?

During night work, you may see increased activities in the area. Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing noisier activities earlier in the night before **midnight**, where possible, and turning off equipment and machinery when not in use. We will not work more than two nights in a row and three nights in the same week at the same location.

Our early morning work is not expected to have any impact on our neighbours.

## Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along the work zone during our work hours to ensure the work zone and traffic are safe while the equipment is used, delivered and removed.
