

## Night work on the M4 Western Motorway (westbound) near Church Street, Parramatta on Sunday 4 June 2023

Transport for NSW will carry out one night of maintenance work on the M4 Western Motorway (westbound) near Church Street, Parramatta on **Sunday 4 June 2023**.

The work will involve installing traffic loop detectors in preparation for M4 Western Motorway ramp metering required as part of finishing works for the Woodville Road, Parramatta Road, Church Street and M4 Western Motorway project.

### Our work schedule

Weather permitting, we will be on site for **one night shift** on **Sunday 4 June**, between **8pm** and **5am**.

If we are unable to carry out the work on this date, the work will be carried out, on Sunday 18 June or Sunday 25 June during the same work hours of 8pm and 5am, weather permitting.

### How will the work affect you?

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers and motorists. Most of the work will not be noisy, however we will do everything we can to minimise impacts including completing the noisier tasks by midnight and turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not in use.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times.
