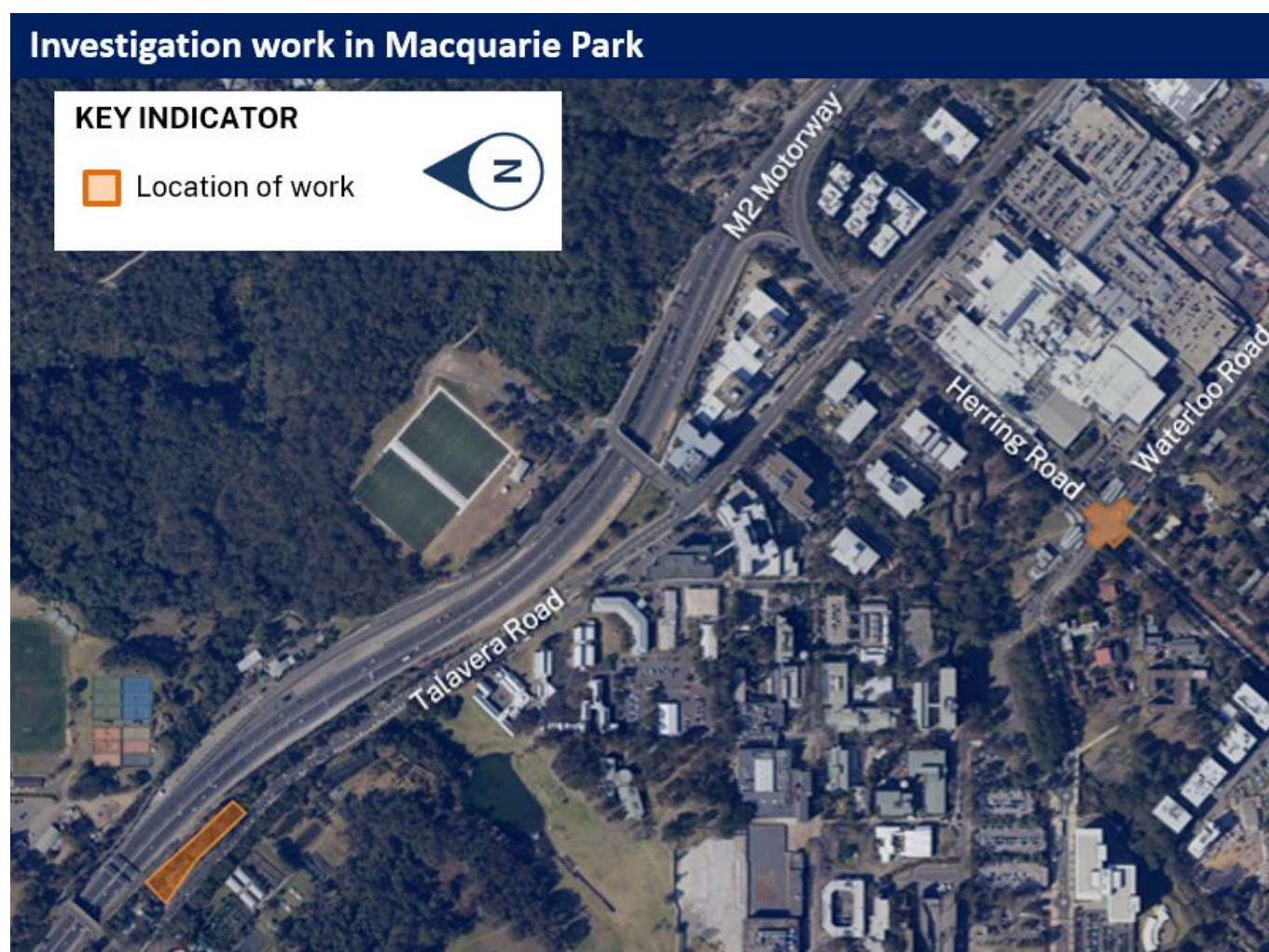
Investigation work for the Macquarie Park Precinct and Bus Interchange

January 2023

The Australian Government and NSW Government are investing nearly \$200 million to improve public transport in Macquarie Park and help create a vibrant ‘heart’ for the precinct.

From **Sunday 5 February**, Transport for NSW will continue investigations to help inform the detailed design of the Macquarie Park Precinct and Bus Interchange.

During this work, we will survey and pothole the footpath and road at the Herring Road and Waterloo Road intersection and Talavera Road in Macquarie Park.



Our work schedule

We will be onsite for **three days** and **five night shifts**, between **Sunday 5 February** and **Friday 31 March 2023**, weather permitting, excluding public holidays.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and from 8am and 1pm on Saturday.

Our night work hours will be between 8pm and 5am from Sunday to Thursday.

How will the work affect you?

Some of our investigation work will occur during the day. However, we will need to carry out most of this work at night to minimise the impact on traffic and to ensure the safety of workers.

Our night work may be noisy at times. We will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including staging the work in different locations and completing the noisier activities by **midnight**.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures and footpath detours will be in place at times which may affect travel times.

Traffic controllers and signs will be in place to help guide pedestrians and motorists through the area. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
