

Mascot Station Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

October 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal, Bidjigal and Gadigal Clans as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is continuing construction of the Mascot Station Upgrade as part of the More Trains, More Services program.

Key features of the work include:

- a new integrated entrance and exit into Mascot Station
- escalators and a lift to the lower paid concourse
- additional ticket gates
- new toilets in the paid concourse of the station.

What work are we doing?

During October there will be ongoing work to the new western entry, at the station, and on Bourke Street.

Work will include:

- footpath reinstatement
- road reinstatement
- electrical work
- saw-cutting
- building fit-out and installation of services within the new western entry
- structural steel installation
- cladding and glazing
- continued mechanical, electrical, communications and plumbing in the station
- commissioning of the new entrance escalators and lift systems
- landscaping around the new station entrance.

When and where we'll be working

Our construction hours are between **7am** and **6pm** Monday to Saturday.

The work will take place within the work site on the western side of Bourke Street.

To carry out the work, the construction workers will be using hand-held tools, road saws, rattle guns, a forklift, jackhammers, concrete saws, concrete pumps, generators, excavators and other construction machinery.

Out-of-hours and Bourke Street reinstatement work

The team will be undertaking out-of-hours work over two consecutive weekends in October to reinstate Bourke Street. These works will take place during the following weekends:

- **6pm Friday 13 October to 7am Monday 16 October**
- **6pm Friday 20 October to 7am Monday 23 October**
- **6pm Friday 27 October to 7am Monday 30 October 2023 (contingency only in case of unexpected conditions).**

What will this mean for you?

The following impacts will take place during the reinstatement work:

- **Road closure of Bourke Street between Gardeners Road and Coward Street from 10pm Friday until 5am Monday each weekend**

Local resident and business access for properties on John Street and Church Avenue will be maintained throughout the work. Pedestrian access along both sides of Bourke Street, Church Avenue, John Street and Etherden Walk will also be maintained.

Detours, signage and traffic control will be in place for motorists. with traffic control in place throughout the work.



Bus stops along Bourke Street between Gardeners Road and O’Riordan Street will be temporarily relocated (see map below). Signage will be in place to notify and direct passengers to alternative temporary bus stops.

What will this mean for you?

You will notice:

- traffic controllers and signage
- noise from machinery and equipment

Changes following road work reinstatement

Following the weekend work in October, you will notice the following changes:

- All bus stops will be reinstated to their original location prior to work starting on the project in 2021. Signage will be installed to notify passengers of these reinstated bus stop locations
- The taxi rank and kiss and ride will remain on John Street near Bourke Street
- The pedestrian crossing will be removed from the corner of Church Avenue and Bourke Street and

reinstated directly between the station entrances on Bourke Street

- The temporary traffic lights on the corner of John and Bourke Streets will be removed with the reinstatement of the zebra crossing on John Street.

Managing our impacts

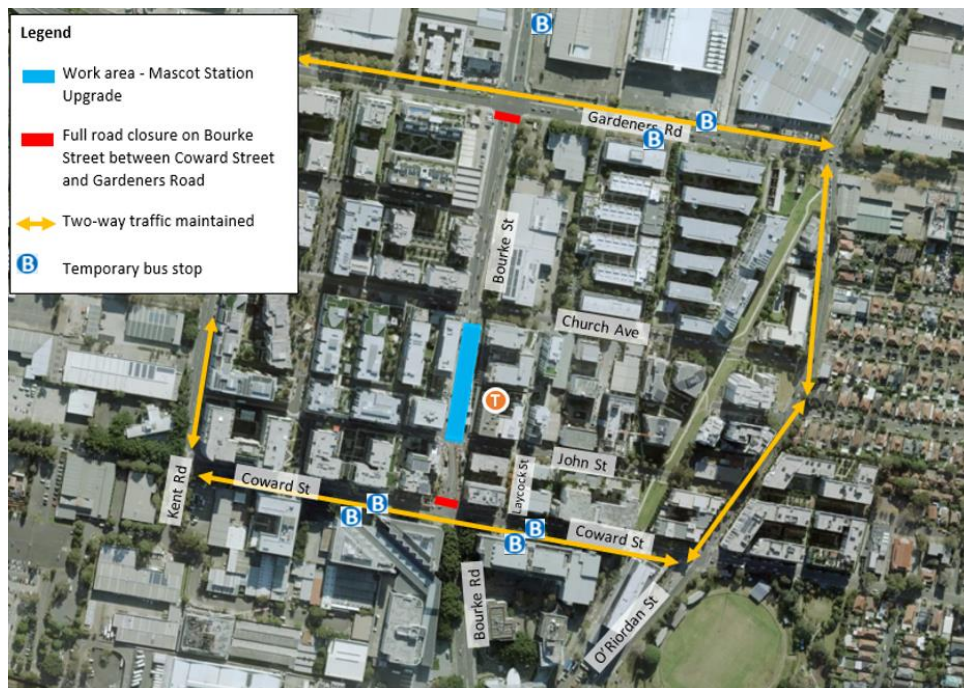
This work may be noisy; however, every effort will be made to minimise noise to the community.
