# Timber girder replacement on McFarlane Bridge, Maclean from 13 June

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work on McFarlane Bridge, about one kilometre south of Maclean, to maintain the structural integrity and heritage value of the bridge and improve safety for road and waterway users.

Transport for NSW will deliver this essential maintenance work from Tuesday, 13 June which includes removing and replacing an existing timber girder.

Work will be carried out Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Sunday 8am to 4pm and is expected to be completed in about two weeks, weather permitting. No work will be carried out on Saturdays.

### How will the work affect you?

This work will involve activities which generate noise. We will make every effort to minimise impacts during high noise activities by turning off machinery when not in use.

## **Traffic changes**

There will be changed traffic conditions while we carry out this work.

As part of this work, there will be three bridge closures\*. At this time, motorists are advised to use the South Arm School Road crossing at Brushgrove as an alternative route, which may add up to 35 minutes to journey times.

Single lane, alternating traffic flows and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place outside the morning and afternoon peaks times resulting in delays of up to 15 minutes.
