Transport for NSW pays respect to the Wiradjuri, Dharug and Gundungara people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is replacing a rail building near Station Street and carrying out early work for the pedestrian bridge near Railway Parade and on the station platform.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Installing telecommunications cables inside the new section hut
- Restoring the areas around our work as we finish investigations and relocations.
- Excavating around existing services to prepare for work under the track
- Using a vacuum truck to create potholes that will help us to locate underground services
- Survey work on the railway track and platform

When and where we'll be working

Most of the work we have been doing takes place from Monday to Friday, 7am to 5pm. However, crews will use an upcoming weekend railway shutdown to continue work in the railway corridor and at Station Street.

Working hours will be from **6am Saturday 27 May** through **to 6pm Sunday 28 May**, weather permitting.

Refer to the map for more information on locations where we will be working.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- An increase in plant and truck movements on Station Street and Railway Parade
- Work activity on the railway platform
- Low level noise during the overnight work
- Traffic controllers and signage along the Great Western Highway and Railway Parade
- Road shoulder closure along 250 metres of the west side of the Highway, north of Station Street

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.


This includes:

- Reducing our noise as much as possible by using plant and machinery during the day
- Turning off machinery when not in use
- Targeting lighting to minimise light spill during night works
- Completing noisy activities by midnight
- Containing night work at Station Street to occur within the section hut itself

We will make every effort to minimise our impacts and will continue to keep you informed as the project progresses.
