Changed traffic conditions for day and nightwork on the Mitchell Highway at Vittoria Curve from Monday 27 March

Safety work will begin on Monday 27 March to upgrade a 1.7 kilometre section of the Mitchell Highway between Bathurst and Orange.

Work will include road widening, vegetation removal, asphalting, construction of a protected right turn bay and the installation of flexible safety barrier on both the edge of the road and on the centreline. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

We will be working from **Monday to Friday** between **7am** and **6pm** and expect to complete this work by **November 2024**, weather permitting.

Additionally, from **Wednesday 29 March**, some asphalting work will take place at night from **6pm** to **7am** and is expected to take **three nights** to complete, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any other work outside these times.

Access to the rest area at Vittoria is also being improved as part of this work, and from **Monday 27** to **Wednesday 29 March**, the rest area will be closed between **7am** and **6pm**, with access restored after 6pm.

How will the work affect you?

For the safety of motorists and our workers, some work will be taking place at night. There will be some noise and lighting associated with this work. We will complete noisier activities before **midnight** and direct lighting away from residences where possible

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency vehicles.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Temporary safety barriers will be in place in some locations to separate the construction site from motorists in some areas.

Lane closures, intermittent stopping and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow an extra five minutes travel time during this work. Outside of work hours, the speed limit will return to 80km/h.


