

Night work on the Mitchell Highway at Vittoria Curve from Wednesday 26 April

The NSW Government is funding important safety work on the Mitchell Highway to provide a stronger, longer lasting and safer road as part of the Vittoria Curve project.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work which includes the removal of trees and vegetation in preparation to widen the road. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

We will be working between 7pm and 6am from **Wednesday 26 April** and expect to complete this work over three nights, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any other work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

For the safety of motorists and our workers, this work will be carried out at night. There will be some noise and lighting associated with this work.

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency vehicles.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

The westbound lane will be closed, intermittent stopping and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow an extra five minutes travel time during this work. Outside of work hours, the speed limit will return to 80km/h.

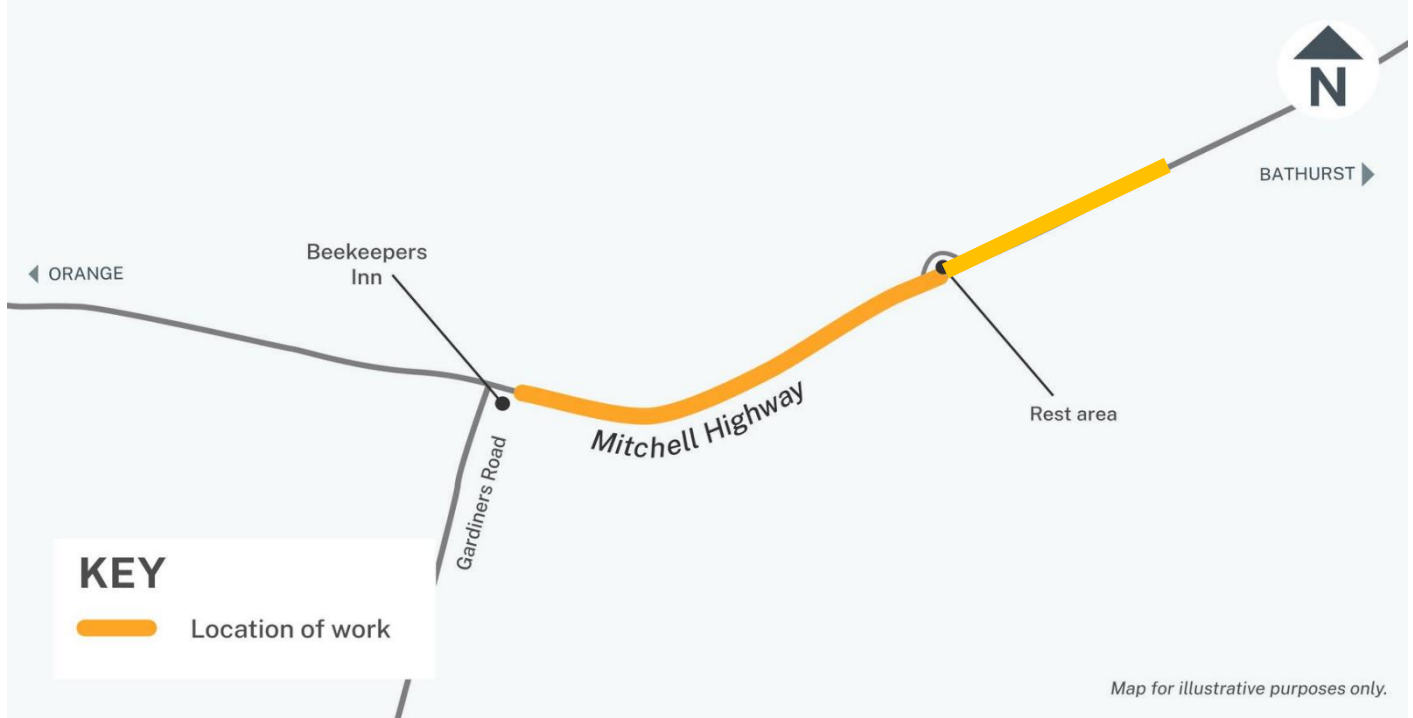
