

# Repairs progressing on landslip sites near Cambewarra Mountain

### Natural disaster recovery on Moss Vale Road

May 2023

## Transport is working to repair landslip damage that will make Moss Vale Road more resilient to the impacts of future severe weather events.

Transport is taking every opportunity to repair landslip damage on Moss Vale Road.

Work begins on Monday 5 June 2023 to repair two landslip sites near Cambewarra Mountain.

#### What work are we doing?

Specialist contractors have been engaged to complete the work.

The repair work includes:

- removing loose rocks, soil and trees
- adding strength to the slope by installing rock bolts and soil nails (long metal rods)
- applying geomesh (a layer of high strength wire mesh and durable turf mat underlay). Shotcrete may be applied in some areas requiring more strength.

#### When and where we'll be working

We'll be on Moss Vale Road between Green Valley Road and the northern end of the single lane section at Cambewarra Mountain.

Days: Monday to Friday only

Times: 7am to 5pm

Dates: Site 35 **5 – 9 June 2023** Site 106 **13 – 16 & 19 June 2023** 

#### What will this mean for you?

There will be minor delays as the road will be reduced to a single lane and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place. These measures are necessary to keep the work sites safe for workers and motorists.

#### Minimising our impacts

We will make every effort to coordinate the traffic control at these sites and the single lane section to minimise the delays.





Specialist contractors working at the first of seven sites in the single lane section on Cambewarra Mountain completed repairs on the landslip area two weeks ahead of schedule.

#### Progress on Cambewarra Mountain

Positive progress has been made with repairs to landslip damage at Cambewarra Mountain.

The work on the first of seven landslip damage sites within the single lane closure section were completed two weeks ahead of schedule.

The faster than expected progress is thanks to some ideal weather conditions, fewer complications than expected at the site and significantly reduced traffic volumes.
