

Night work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road – Tuesday 6 and Wednesday 7 June 2023

Transport for NSW will continue to carry out work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. Some work will need to be carried out at night on 6 and 7 June 2023.

What work are we doing?

We will be working on the median of Mulgoa Road and at the corner of side streets for utility investigations.

Work includes:

- Locating existing underground services
- Using machinery to investigate the median
- Restoring the works when our investigations are finished.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working along the whole project area between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road at different locations (see map overleaf).

Working hours are 6pm to 5am on Tuesday 6 June and Wednesday 7 June, 2023. In case of bad weather we will work on Thursday 8 June.

Noisy work

The work involves taking samples of the median material, hydro excavation to locate underground utilities and backfilling and compacting.

Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use.

One lane in each direction on Mulgoa Road will be closed to traffic, with traffic controllers on duty to guide vehicles.

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Road closures and reduced speed limits
- Footpath closures
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Traffic changes

While we will try minimising disruption to traffic temporary traffic changes will be required at times to ensure the work zone is safe. Partial lane closures and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be in place near our work area.
