Transport for NSW will continue to carry out work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. Work is scheduled at night on 17, 18, 20 and 24 July 2023.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Drilling to test road conditions
- Using machinery in the road median
- Restoring the worksite when work is finished.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, in the road median, at the corner of side streets and on the M4 east and west bound on and off ramps (see map overleaf).

Working hours are **6pm to 5am on:**

- **Monday 17, Tuesday 18, Thursday 20, and Monday 24 July 2023.**
- **In case of bad weather, we will work on Wednesday 19, Friday 21, and/or Tuesday 25 July 2023.**

Noisy work

We will be using machinery such as core drill, excavators, chainsaws, jackhammer, vibratory rollers, bobcat, a chipper, vacuum truck, other trucks for transporting material and saw cutting equipment.

We will try and complete the noisier part of the work before midnight. However, there may be

some intermittent noisy work after midnight. There may be some vibration impacts from this work.

Our schedule of work

- **Monday 17 July** – Working on the road median between Wolseley Street to Surveyors Creek. Placing asphalt from M4 to Wolseley Street. Saw cutting island on M4 Eastbound on ramp. Road testing at the corner of Mulgoa Road and Jeanette Street. Clearing works on the M4 Eastbound On Ramp.
- **Tuesday 18 July** – Working on the road median between Wolseley Street to Surveyors Creek. Placing asphalt from M4 to Wolseley Street. Road testing at the corner of Mulgoa Road and Jeanette Street.
- **Thursday 20 July** – Road testing along Mulgoa Road. Working on the road median on the M4 Eastbound ramp island. Placing asphalt on between Jeanette Street to Wolseley Street.
- **Monday 24 July** – Road testing along Mulgoa Road. Working on the road median on the M4 Eastbound island. Placing asphalt from Wolseley Street to Surveyors Creek.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used on all the above nights.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use.

One lane in each direction on Mulgoa Road will be closed to traffic, and one lane on the west and east

bound on and off ramps will be closed, with traffic controllers on duty to guide vehicles.

Traffic changes

While we will try and minimise disruption to traffic, temporary traffic changes will be required at times to ensure the work zone is safe. **The Eastbound on ramp will be closed on the 17 July 2023.** Lane


closures and a reduced 40km/h speed limit will be in place near our work area.
