Changed traffic conditions on the Newell Highway in Narrabri on Saturday 6 May 2023

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential maintenance works on the Newell Highway in Narrabri.

Narrabri Shire Council will deliver the work which will include resealing the road surface in four locations in Narrabri between the Lloyd Street intersection and Wee Waa Road intersection on the Newell Highway.

Crews will be working between **9am** and **5pm** on **Saturday 6 May** and expect to complete the work in one day, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Single lane closures, intermittent stopping and a 40 km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Outside work hours, both lanes will return to the existing speed limit of 50 km/h.

Motorists should allow up to 5 minutes extra travel time during this work.


