

# Changed traffic conditions at two locations in Dubbo as part of the New Dubbo Bridge project

#### What work are we doing?

Construction is continuing at various locations in Dubbo throughout June and July by our head contractor Abergeldie Complex Infrastructure.

Work includes:

- Utility relocation and upgrade work
- Utility investigations and traffic controls including barriers and temporary lane realignment
- Continuation of land piling
- Setting up environmental controls, clearing and removal of stone wall at Wiradjuri Park

#### When and where we'll be working

Crews will be installing traffic barriers and relocating utilities at the intersection of **Bourke Street and River Street** from Tuesday 6 June.

From Monday 3 July work will be carried out to remove the median strips at the intersection of **Whylandra Street and Thompson Street.** 

Our standard work hours will be **Monday to Friday** from **7am to 6pm** and **Saturday** between **8am and 1pm**. There is no planned work on
Sundays and public holidays.

# Night work

To minimise traffic impacts, some work will be completed at night.

Night work will be carried out from **6pm to 7am** for up to 18 night shifts across June and July.

#### What will this mean for you?

To enable the utility relocation and upgrade, the road shoulders of Bourke Street and River Street will be closed. Barriers will be in place with access to businesses maintained at all times.

You may also notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Concrete barriers in the road shoulders
- Reduced speed limits of 40km/h
- Footpath and lane closures
- · Noise from machinery and equipment

#### Managing our impacts


We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.
