


Changed traffic conditions on the Princes Highway

Nowra Bridge project

September 2023







Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Over the coming weeks the final layer of road pavement will be placed across the project area.

What work are we doing?

Work will soon begin to place the final layer of road pavement, also known as the wearing course, on the Princes Highway from Mattes Way to Moss Street.

This work will be carried out over several weeks during night work, and this notification outlines work scheduled over the first two-week period.

Work includes:

- Placing and removing temporary barriers
- Asphalting activities
- Traffic light adjustments
- Line marking

When and where we'll be working

Work will be carried out on the Princes Highway between Mattes Way and Moss Street, and on sections of Bolong, Illaroo and Bridge Roads.

To reduce impacts to road users, work will take place at night between 7pm and 6am, from Sunday 10 September to Thursday 21 September 2023, weather permitting.

What will this mean for you?

For the safety of workers and road users there will be single lane closures, stop/slow traffic

conditions, and a reduce speed of 40 km/h will be in place during night work.

There will also be temporary closures and access restrictions to several local roads during some of this work.

These traffic changes will be in place during night work only, and detours will be in place. Details of these changes are included in this notification.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during work hours however there may be some changes. Road users are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.

While we aim to minimise our impacts, nearby residents may experience some additional noise from vehicles and machinery.

Detours will be in place

While this night work is carried out, the usual detours will be in place. During the closure of Bolong Road, light vehicles will be detoured via Beinda Street, and heavy vehicles will be detoured by Railway Street, and then Cambewarra Road and Meroo Road.

During the temporary closure of Bridge Road, a detour will be in place for all vehicles via the Princes Highway, Moss Street and North Street.

In addition, while Illaroo Road is restricted to leftin and left-out movements, motorists will be detoured via the Beinda Street roundabout and via the Princes Highway, Moss Street and North Street.

Local road closures during night work

While we aim to provide the community with accurate information in advance, over the coming weeks these dates may change due to weather impacts and associated scheduling impacts.

Electronic message boards will be in place before and during closures to advise motorists in advance of impacts and detours. Resident and business access will be maintained at all times.

Location	Dates
Bolong Road will be closed between the Princes Highway and Beinda Street for three nights.	Sunday 10 September to Tuesday 12 September
Bridge Road will be closed between the Princes Highway and Hyam Street for one night.	Wednesday 13 September
Fairway Drive will be closed for one night. There will be no access to the golf course or wharf.	Monday 18 September
Illaroo Road will be restricted to left-in and left-out only for three nights.	Tuesday 19 September to Thursday 21 September
Heavy vehicles will be restricted from using the right turn out of Bolong Road onto the Princes Highway for three nights.	Tuesday 19 September to Thursday 21 September
