

Restoration work continues, Oxley Highway, Mount Seaview

July 2023

The NSW Government is funding essential reconstruction work on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview to repair damage in areas affected by natural disasters.

We are continuing major restoration work on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview following flooding in 2021 and 2022.

How will the work affect you?

From Monday 17 July, restoration work on Slip 5 and 6 will start with work expected to be complete in about 12 weeks, weather permitting.

This work will involve the use of soil nails to complete the stabilisation at the two slip site locations.

Our work hours are from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday. No work is scheduled to be carried out on Sundays or public holidays.



Traffic changes

Single lane, alternating traffic flow arrangements and reduced speed limits will be in place for the duration of the work. Short stoppages of up to 10 minutes may be required during work hours.

Motorists should plan their journeys and allow extra travel time.

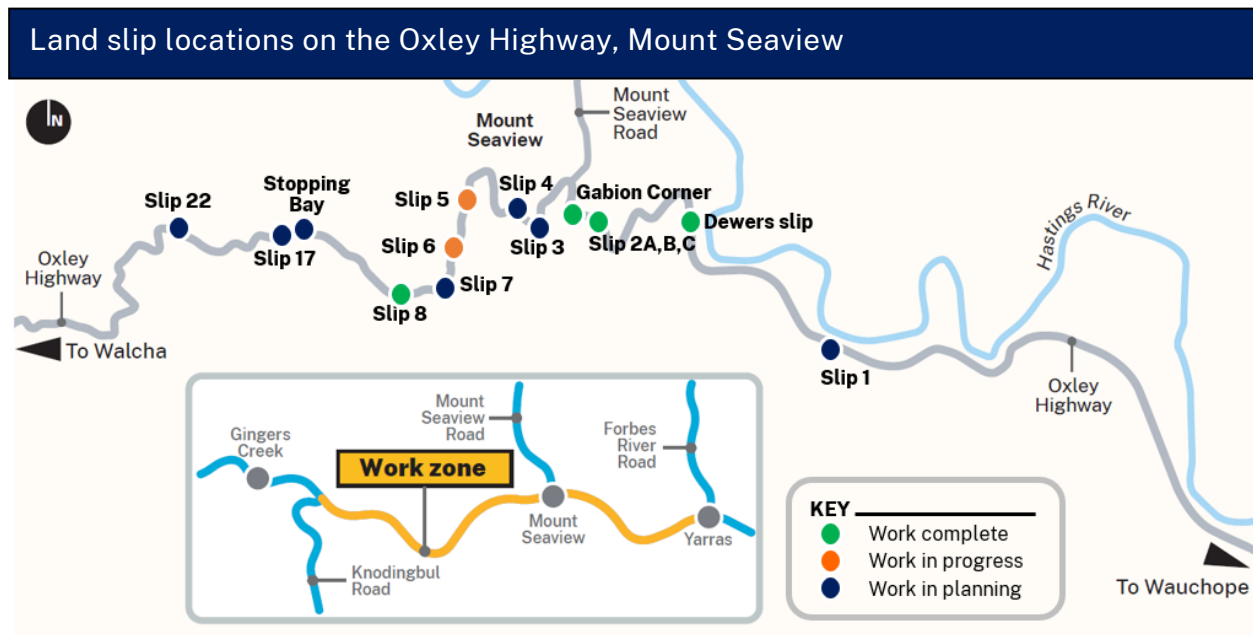

Current and future work

The culvert replacement program which started in April 2023 is ongoing with completion expected in October. We have invested over \$2 million in upgrading existing concrete culverts to high density polyethylene pipes.

Planning is continuing for Slip 4 and Slip 22 with construction expected to start during late 2023. As we progress to these more complex slip sites, full road closures will be required.

We will keep the community informed of the nature and timing of planned road closures well in advance.
