Hexham Straight Widening

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing in the upgrade of the section of Maitland Road known as Hexham Straight, between Newcastle Inner City Bypass and Hexham Bridge

Transport for NSW will be completing night work in January for the safety of motorists and workers and to ensure work is carried out as efficiently as possible.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Installation of barriers and line-marking
- Removal and building new road pavements, including asphaltting
- Service investigations
- Traffic signal works

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on the Maitland Road between the Newcastle Inner City Bypass and the Oak Precinct from **Monday 8 January to Wednesday 31 January**.

Normal working hours are between **7am** and **6pm** on **weekdays** and **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

Night work will happen between **7pm** and **5am** from **Sunday to Thursday**, weather permitting.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Lane closures and traffic control
- A temporary 40 km/h reduced speed limit
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Managing our impacts

The out of hours work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.


Directly affected residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption during the work.

Upcoming community consultation

Our community agreement for out of hours work expires at the end of December 2023. Over the coming weeks, we will be seeking your feedback to continue this agreement in 2024 to work up to five nights in a row, weather permitting.

We will continue to provide the community the opportunity to share feedback and keep you updated as the project progresses.





Our night work schedule

Activity	Duration
Service investigation on Maitland Road between the Newcastle Inner City Bypass and Hexham Railway Station	5 nights
Removal of the median on Maitland Road between Hexham Station and the Oak Precinct	5 nights
Building temporary pavements in the median on Maitland Road between Shamrock Street and Hexham Bowling Club	5 nights
Asphalting and additional barrier placement between Shamrock Street and Hexham Railway Station	10 nights
Installation of concrete barriers on the Maitland Road between the Calvary St Josephs and Ironbark Creek Bridge	5 nights
Work on the traffic control signals at the intersection of Newcastle Inner City Bypass and Maitland Road	2 nights
Line-marking on Maitland Road between Newcastle Inner City Bypass and Old Maitland Road	1 night
Geotechnical investigation work on Maitland Road between Sparke Street and Ironbark Creek Bridge	3 nights
Building pavements on Maitland Road between Sparke Street and Ironbark Creek Bridge	3 nights
