Geotechnical investigation at Paytens Bridge and Paytens Bridge Road from Monday 20 June 2022

The NSW Government is providing \$250,000 to investigate options for replacing Paytens Bridge with a new concrete bridge. The bridge is located over the Lachlan River on Paytens Bridge Road.

Transport for NSW will be conducting geotechnical investigations on Paytens Bridge Road which will include the use of a drilling rig. We have included a map to show the site of these works.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday 20 June** and expect to complete the work in **seven days**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe throughout the duration of the works from **Monday 20 June** to **Sunday 26 June**.

Intermittent lane closures will be in place as investigation work is conducted. A full closure of the single lane bridge will occur at the start and completion of the works for up to 10 minutes to allow loading and unloading of plant and equipment.

There will be a 40km/h speed limit in place to ensure the safety of motorists and workers while work is being conducted. Motorists should allow up to 10 minutes extra travel time during this work.
