


# Tree removal work at Paytens Bridge on Paytens Bridge Road from Monday 28 August

# The NSW Government is investigating options to replace Paytens Bridge on Paytens Bridge Road.

#### What work are we doing?

The work will include tree trimming and removal of three trees near the bridge to provide access to the Lachlan River for geotechnical investigations for the Paytens Bridge replacement project.

#### When and where we'll be working

We will be working between 7am and 5pm from Monday 28 August. We expect to complete the work in up to five days, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times. All work activities and dates are subject to weather and site conditions.

We will be working at Paytens Bridge on Paytens Bridge Road, around 350 metres north of the Lachlan Valley Way intersection and 11 kilometres south west of Eugowra.

We have included a map to show the area of the work.

## What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Traffic control, intermittent lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place during work hours.

Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.

The speed limit will return to 100 km/h outside of work hours.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

We understand that this work will generate some inconvenience and we thank you for your patience.
