


# Sydney Harbour Bridge Cycleway Northern Access Project

## Site investigations

September/October 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Cammeraygal people of Eora nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for New South Wales is progressing plans to upgrade the existing cycleway connection between the Sydney Harbour Bridge cycleway and the bike network in Milsons Point.

To complete detail design, we will be undertaking investigative works in Bradfield Park North from **Friday 15 September until Friday 13 October**, weather permitting.

#### What work are we doing?

During September and October, we will be carrying out:

- geotechnical investigations and contamination testing to assess soil and ground conditions
- service investigations to determine the location of underground utilities
- arborist assessment of trees and root mapping to identify structural root zones.

#### When and where we'll be working

We will be working from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

#### What will this mean for you?

There will be some temporary changes for pedestrians and cyclists when we're working next to footpaths and at the station entrance. Traffic controllers will be in place to provide directions.

Equipment to be used includes a drill rig and support truck, vacuum trucks, and an elevated work platform, which will move between sites.

Steel road plates will be placed on the footpath when needed.

#### Managing our impacts

We will minimise impacts to the community and the environment by:

- reducing noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using nontonal reversing beepers
- installing noise blankets where possible
- installing signage and having traffic controllers there to direct pedestrians.

# Temporary parking, pedestrian and bus stop changes

For the safety of our workers and pedestrians, there will be a temporary closure of up to 24 car spaces, including 18 car spaces along Alfred Street and six car spaces along Burton Street. Spaces are needed to park equipment and small trucks (vacuum trucks). Please use alternate street parking during this time.

Temporary fencing will be installed around work zones, including any trenches and boreholes.

For footpath detours on Alfred Street, please follow the directions on the temporary signs and from traffic controllers.

To enable this work we will need to temporarily move the bus stop on Alfred Street at the southern end of Bradfield Park Plaza about 60 metres north on Alfred Street. Traffic controllers will be in place to help customers. We understand our work may cause some inconvenience and we thank you for your patience during this time.
