


Changed traffic conditions on the Kamilaroi Highway at Spring Creek



August 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is carrying out early works on the Kamilaroi Highway at Spring Creek Bridge, about 9.5 kilometres west of Narrabri.

We have included a map to show the location of the works.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW is carrying out the works which will include the construction of a sealed side-track as part of early works. The side-track will provide for safe two-lane traffic flow on the Kamilaroi Highway during the construction phase of the bridge replacement project which is planned to commence in 2024.

When we'll be working

Work will be carried out from **Monday 7 August 2023** for about 12 weeks, weather permitting.

Work hours are between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Saturday.**

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

What will this mean for you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 60km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.


Outside work hours, both lanes will be open and revert to the posted speed limit.

Motorists should allow up to **five minutes of** additional travel time.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
