



St Peters Station Upgrade Community Update

Transport Access Program

August 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Wangal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The St Peters Station Upgrade is delivered as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

What work are we doing in August?

We will be:

- Continuing landscaping on Railway Lane
- Installing roofing for the stair canopies
- Installing cladding and glazing on the new lifts
- Installing an opal card reader on Platform 3
- Installing and testing CCTV
- Installing handrails on platforms 3 and 4
- Installing signage on the lifts and platform seats.

When and where we'll be working

Work at the station continues **Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Intermittent periods of high noise
- Increase in construction traffic
- Temporary parking restrictions: at times, up to eight spaces on Lord Street will be temporarily unavailable to allow for site deliveries to take place.
- Temporary closure of station facilities: the Station Master's office and the existing station toilets are currently closed due to the discovery of corrosion

and termite damage. This is currently being investigated by the project team.

Changes to scheduled work

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be a significant change to the construction program.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- The use of noise blankets where possible, replacing reversing beepers with clickers
- Traffic control and signage
- Directional lighting pointed away from residential properties wherever possible.
