


Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade – Seven Hills

More Trains, More Services

November 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Toogagal and Toongabbit people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers.

This project will upgrade the infrastructure inside the rail corridor at Seven Hills to improve train movements through the station.

What work are we doing?

We will install new overhead wiring structures and strengthen existing structures to enable them to last longer.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

For safety reasons some work will take place outside of standard construction hours when no trains are running from 10pm Friday 17 November through to 2am Monday 20 November 2023.

We will be working inside the rail corridor and will use site access points on Terminus Road and Hartley Road to load/unload material and equipment as shown on the map overleaf.

What will this mean for you?

Some of our work will take place next to a live train line. For safety reasons, we will use a warning system consisting of small explosive devices to alert train drivers that there is work on track. This is standard practice when work is happening inside the rail corridor.

The warning system will be used inside the rail corridor near Blacktown Creek between 6am and 6pm on:

- Saturday 18 November
- Sunday 19 November.

During this time, you may notice short bursts of loud noise (similar to a starting pistol at a running race) and see puffs of smoke inside the rail corridor.

You may also notice:

- workers and heavy vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption for the community.

We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
