In summary, the proposal involves:

- removal of kerbside parking along The Grand Parade and Sandringham Street during the proposed new and extended clearway hours (Rocky Point Road, including Bonney Street, Myers Street and Bonanza Parade are no longer included in this proposal)
- providing alternative business parking on state and local roads close to The Grand Parade
- place amenities on local roads (subject to council approval).

Next steps

Transport is committed to progressing this project and will continue to work closely with local councils and key stakeholders over the coming months to further develop the proposal in response to the feedback received from the community and stakeholders.

We will provide an update to the community on the development and implementation of the proposal in mid-2023.
