

Traffic changes at the intersection of Princes Highway and Sydney Park Road, St Peters

Community update | February 2023



Location of Intersection changes on Princes Highway, St Peters

From **Sunday 19 February**, Transport for NSW will modify the intersection of Princes Highway and Sydney Park Road. We are making these changes as part of traffic calming measures for the area.

The changes include:

- moving the start of the third lane on Princes Highway southbound to a new location south of May Street
- changing the through traffic and right turn lane into May Street on Princes Highway southbound into right turn only
- removing one of the two right turning lanes from Princes Highway northbound into Sydney Park Road.

Motorists are encouraged to use the upgraded Campbell Road and Euston Road as an alternative route to travel northbound.

How will the work affect you?

Work is expected to take four shifts to complete between **Sunday 19 February** and **Thursday 2 March**, weather permitting. Work hours are **Sunday** to **Thursday** between **8pm** and **5am**. We will keep you informed if we need to work outside of these times.

Temporary lane closures will be required at night to complete the planned work, which will involve line marking. There will be some noise associated with the work and every effort will be made to minimise this impact.

Traffic changes

There will be traffic changes to allow the work to take place and to ensure the work zone is safe.

Temporary lane closures are required and will occur at night however, one lane in each direction will be kept open at all times. There will be a 40km/h work zone speed limit in place during work hours. Parking will be temporarily removed northbound on Princes Highway between Goodsell Street and May Street during the work.

Drivers should plan ahead and allow extra travel time. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Motorists travelling northbound, particularly those exiting the M8 Motorway, are encouraged to use Campbell Road and Euston Road. These roads have been upgraded to six lanes and have a 60km/h speed limit.
