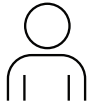

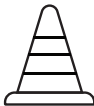

At the end of the four-year program, you might consider continuing your studies towards a Civil Engineering degree at a university of your choice, independently.

During your time as a TfNSW trainee, you'll be working closely with experts in the field and learning from inspiring leaders. You'll also develop the technical expertise and skills to secure a job in the road or traffic related industry.
