


Turrella Station Upgrade Community Update

Transport Access Program

October 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Turrella Station Upgrade is delivered as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and passengers with luggage.

What are we doing in October?

Work includes:

- plumbing, electrical, tiling and carpentry activities within the station unisex toilet and station master room
- kerb and footpath work on Turrella Street and Reede Street bridge
- new line marking on Reede Street bridge and Turrella Street
- installing structural steel for the new station entrance structure
- lighting for the station platform and new station entrance
- installing lift equipment and internal lift fit out
- installing new wayfinding signs around the station.

The above work involves the delivery and removal of construction material and equipment, as well as the use of heavy equipment such as cranes, concrete pumps, excavators and vehicles modified to operate on the railway.

Traffic and pedestrian detours will also be in place.

When we'll be working

Our construction hours will be between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Out of hours work

Four nights between **6pm Monday 23 October** and **7am Friday 27 October** we will be working during a Sydney
Trains trackwork period, with buses replacing trains. At
this time, mobilisation and set-up activities for crane
lifting will take place. Impacted residents will be
contacted individually.

For the duration of these works, partial closures of Reede Street bridge will occur. Traffic control signage will be in place during this work.

Throughout these works, access to the site compound at 127-135 Turrella Street will be required.

Schedules and work are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions.

Temporary lane closures on Reede Street bridge

For the remainder of the project, one lane of Reede Street bridge will continue to be closed intermittently during construction hours.

This is for the set-up of equipment and to carry out work on the station platform, footpath and station entry.

Traffic control will be in place during the closures.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- footpath closures
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times under traffic management.

Follow traffic signage and allow for additional travel time during this period

Location of work and bus changes


