



Turrella Station Upgrade Community Update

Transport Access Program

September 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Turrella Station Upgrade is delivered as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

What are we doing in September?

Work includes:

- plumbing, electrical, tiling and carpentry activities within the station unisex toilet and station master room
- service identification and investigation
- kerb and footpath work on Turrella Street and Reede Street bridge
- demolition of medium island on Reede Street
- new line marking on Reede Street bridge and Turrella Street
- removal of temporary pedestrian crossing and installation of the new permanent crossing
- installation of precast staircase
- installation of lift shaft and concourse canopy
- resurfacing station platform.

The above work involves delivery and removal of construction material and equipment, as well as the use of heavy equipment such as cranes, concrete pumps, excavators and vehicles modified to operate on the railway. During the work, traffic and pedestrian detours will be in place.

When we'll be working

Our construction hours will be between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Ausgrid night work

Ausgrid will be removing a street light pole on Turrella Street between **Monday 11 and Thursday 14 September 2023**. A temporary solar street light will be set up until the light pole is replaced. This work is expected take one night shift to complete and impacted residents will be notified prior to work taking place.

Out of hours work

From **6pm Friday 15 September** until **7am Monday 18 September** we will be working during a Sydney Trains trackwork weekend, with buses replacing trains. At this time, mobilisation and set-up activities for crane lifting work will take place.

For the duration of these works, full and partial closures of Turrella and Reede streets will occur, with detours and bus stop relocations. Traffic control signage will be in place during this work. Impacted residents will be contacted individually. We have included a map over the page.

Throughout the weekend, access to the site compound at 127-135 Turrella Street will be required.

Access to rail tracks will be via Bardwell Park and Henderson Street. Traffic control will provide guidance to drivers in these locations.

Temporary lane closures on Reede Street bridge

One lane of Reede Street bridge will continue to be closed intermittently during construction hours until October 2023, for the set-up of equipment and to carry out work on the station platform, footpath and station entry. Traffic control will be in place during the closures.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- footpath closures
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times under traffic management. Follow traffic signage and allow for additional travel time during this period.
