

Turrella Station Upgrade Community Update

Transport Access Program

November 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Turrella Station Upgrade is delivered as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and passengers with luggage.

What are we doing in November?

Work includes:

- removing the temporary stairs and opening the new stairs for passengers
- removing the temporary hoarding on the platform and around the new staircase and lift shaft
- fitting out the station unisex toilet and station master room
- regrading the platform
- kerb, footpath and balustrade work on Turrella Street and Reede Street bridge
- installing the new horizontal screen fence on Reede Street bridge
- installing the new station entrance structure
- · installing and fitting out the lift.

The above work involves delivery and removal of construction material and equipment, as well as the use of heavy equipment such as cranes, concrete pumps, excavators and vehicles modified to operate on the railway. Traffic and pedestrian detours will be in place, during the work.

When we'll be working

Our construction hours will be between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Out of hours work

From 6pm Friday 24 November until 7am Monday 27 November we will be working during a Sydney Trains trackwork period. Buses will replace trains during this time until services resume on Monday morning. At this time, mobilisation and set-up activities for crane lifting work will take place. Impacted residents will be contacted individually.

For the duration of this work, full and partial closures of Turrella and Reede streets will occur. Traffic control signage will be in place during this work. We have included a map over the page.

Throughout the work, access to the site compound at 127-135 Turrella Street will be required.

Schedules and work are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions.

Temporary lane closures on Reede Street bridge

For the remainder of the project, one lane of Reede Street bridge will continue to be closed intermittently during construction hours, for the set-up of equipment and to carry out work on the station platform, footpath and station entry. Traffic control will be in place during the closures.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- footpath closures
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times under traffic management. Follow traffic signage and allow for additional travel time during this period.
