



# Wakehurst Parkway Improvements Frenchs Forest to Narrabeen

## Investigation work

April 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gayamagal and Garigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing \$75 million on improvements for Wakehurst Parkway between Frenchs Forest Road, Frenchs Forest and Pittwater Road, Narrabeen with a focus on safety and capacity for this key link in Sydney's Northern Beaches.

As previously advised in January 2023, as part of the development for these improvements, Transport plans to carry out investigation works to better understand and inform the different options being considered.

Due to recent adverse weather, the initial investigation period will be extended from **Monday 1 May 2023 through to late June 2023**, weather permitting.

### What's planned?

Investigation work will be carried out along Wakehurst Parkway between Pittwater Road and Frenchs Forest Road.

The key areas will include:

- Trefoil Creek
- Dreadnought Road
- Oxford Falls Road
- Middle Creek Reserve
- Elanora Road
- Mirrool Street

These works will involve, land surveys, utility investigations, flora and

fauna surveys, geotechnical surveys, and pavement investigations including boring and minor excavation work.

### Work schedule

Investigation work is scheduled to take place from **Monday 1 May to late June 2023**, weather permitting.

Please note, work will not be constant throughout this period. Investigation work will be carried out in stages across the 9.5km corridor and will cover day and night shifts.

Day shift hours are **7am to 6pm Mondays to Fridays** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Night hours are **8pm to 5am Mondays to Saturdays**.

We will not work on Sundays or public holidays at this stage. Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be significant changes to our construction schedule.

### How this work may affect you

While the majority of work will be carried out alongside Wakehurst Parkway with minimal impacts to traffic, temporary traffic changes will be required at various times to ensure work zones are safe.

This may include partial lane closures and reduced 40km/h speed limits near our work areas.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.





### How this work may affect you cont.

Some work may be noisy at times. We will do everything we can to minimise these impacts where possible.

Access to some properties may be affected during our work.

We will notify any impacted properties prior to work commencing and discuss alternative access arrangements with property owners directly as required.
