


Night works on Erskine Street in Dubbo from Tuesday 13 June

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential maintenance work in Dubbo.

What work are we doing?

The work will include asphalting between Bligh Street and Darling Street to repair and replace damaged road surfaces.

We have included a map to show the area of the work.

When we'll be working

We will be working between **8pm** and **6am** for **three weeks** from **Tuesday 13 June.**

We expect to complete the work in **15 nights**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary restrictions to vehicle and pedestrian access to each property for around **two hours** while the work is carried out.

Please ensure vehicles are parked off-street prior to the commencement of work at 8pm each night, for the three-week duration of works.

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the evening and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Please contact us if you have any specific requirements that need to be met during this time.

Managing our impacts

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

The road will remain open with single lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit in place for the duration of works, which may affect travel times.

During the work, there will be temporary access restrictions to Erskine Street from Macquarie, Bligh, Brisbane, and Macleay Streets.

All motorists including residents will be required to use alternate accesses to Erskine Street via the signposted detour along Talbragar and Darling Street, or Macleay and Darling Street.

There will be no access to side roads except via the detour.

Where there is no detour available, such as to Park Street or the southern end of Brisbane Street, access will be maintained via traffic control.


Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time.
