

Work continues at Little Hartley January 2024

Coxs River Road Upgrade
January 2024

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's lead contractor, Ertech is continuing works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

What work are we doing?

Earthworks and construction activities will continue across the site over the **next six to eight weeks** including:

East of Coxs River Road

- Soil nailing and shotcrete
- Constructing detention basins
- Installing drainage
- Building the new Coxs River Road
- Building the Coxs River Road Bridge
- Borehole drilling for water assessment

West of Coxs River Road

- Installing drainage lines
- Constructing detention basins

Around Browns Gap Road

- Building a concrete footpath
- Landscaping
- Asphalting

- Installing road furniture and line marking
- Developing tie-in works with Great Western Highway

When and where we'll be working

We will continue working under our standard working hours between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.**

If we need to work outside of these hours we will notify you in advance.

What will this mean for you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on residents. However, you will notice:

- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Plant movement in and out of the project site
- Traffic control and reduced speed limits in place. Please allow an additional five minutes for your travel time.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing work areas for safety and security.
- Watercarts are in use daily to assist in controlling dust.
- Reducing our noise as much as possible by working in stages and turning off machinery when not in use.
