


# Nightworks at Little Hartley from 4 February

Coxs River Road Upgrade
January 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges people of the Wiradjuri Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's lead contractor, Ertech, is carrying out the works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

## What work are we doing?

We'll be carrying out works in preparation for the traffic switch from the existing highway to the new service road.

#### West of Browns Gap Road

- Completing the western tie-in from the service road to the Great Western Highway
- Removing and re line-marking the Great Western Highway and Browns Gap Road.

#### East of Browns Gap Road

 Completing the eastern tie-in from the service road to the Great Western Highway.

#### Traffic switch

- Traffic will be switched from the Great
  Western Highway to the newly built service
  road via the eastern and western tie-ins
  overnight between Wednesday 14 and
  Thursday 15 February.
- Traffic will leave the existing Highway onto the service road for approximately 300m where it will re-join the existing highway.

### When and where we'll be working

We'll be working over six nights between **Sunday 4 February and Wednesday 14 February 2024**, weather permitting.

Night working hours are **8pm to 5am** Sunday night to Friday morning.

We will be carrying out this work at night, for the safety of workers and to cause the least disturbance to highway traffic.

#### What will this mean for you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on residents. However, you may notice:

- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Plant movement in and out of the project site
- Lighting towers
- Traffic control and reduced speed limits to 60km/h will be in place. Please allow an additional five minutes for your travel time.

# Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing work areas for safety and security
- Directing lights away from homes
- Reducing our noise as much as possible by working in stages and turning off machinery when not in use
