


Repairing damage on the M1 southbound off ramp at Helensburgh

Natural disaster recovery

January 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the people of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is repairing landslip damage on the M1 Princes Motorway southbound off ramp at Helensburgh.

The off ramp will be closed during work hours with a reduced speed limit in place outside work.

What work are we doing?

The work is part of the natural disaster recovery response across the state's road network by Transport for NSW.

Work includes:

- adding rockfill to add strength to the edge of the road and the bank below the off ramp
- reinstalling guardrail and kerbing.

When and where we'll be working

Work will begin on Sunday 28 January 2024.

We expect to complete the work on **Thursday 8 February 2024**, weather permitting.

Work hours are **8pm to 4am, Sunday to Thursday.**

What will this mean for you?

This work will mean:

- a detour via the Princes Highway for motorists travelling between Waterfall and Helensburgh during work hours (8pm to 4am)
- a reduced speed limit of 60 km/h at the off ramp outside work hours
- some noise near the work area from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:


- working at night to minimise impact on motorists
- reducing our noise as much as possible.

Natural disaster recovery

Parts of the Illawarra and South Coast received record-breaking rainfall in 2022.

This heavy rainfall caused widespread damage on many roads, including landslips at 26 separate sites on Lawrence Hargrave Drive.

Since the damage occurred, Transport for NSW has completed repairs at half of these sites.

Our geotechnical team monitor all sites until repairs are completed.
