



# The Horsley Drive and Polding Street, Fairfield – Investigation works

## Community Notification

April 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug people of the Cabrogal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is proposing to upgrade the intersection of The Horsley Drive and Polding Street, Fairfield to ease congestion, improve safety and travel times for all road users.

Transport will be carrying out utility investigation work. This essential work will determine the location of existing utilities to inform the design of The Horsley Drive and Polding Street intersection upgrades.

### What work are we doing?

Investigation work will take place along The Horsley Drive and Polding Street, including surround roads.

Work includes:

- potholing and minor excavation
- utility investigations
- trenching

### When we will be working

Work will take place over **five-night shifts** between **Sunday 5 May and Thursday 16 May** weather permitting.

To ensure the safety of our workers and to minimise the impact to road users, this work must be carried out at night.

Our night shift hours are from **Sunday to Thursday** between the hours of **6pm** and **5am**.

**No work will occur on Friday or Saturday nights.**

### What will this mean for you?

Work will be undertaken at night to limit the disruption to road users and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, buses, and motorists.

This work may generate some noise, but we will do everything we can to minimise noise impacts, including:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not in use
- completing the noisier tasks by midnight

### Traffic impacts

There will be lane closures at different times to facilitate this work. A 400m contraflow will be in place to enable the closure of one lane with traffic control managing traffic in both directions and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h and traffic control.

While we complete this work, you may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closure and reduced speed limit.

Road users are advised to allow for additional travel time, drive to the conditions, and follow the directions of traffic controllers and signs.
