



What work are we doing?

Several infrastructure improvements are currently being delivered in your area as part of this program, including:

- Wolli Creek Power Supply Upgrade project
- Arncliffe to Tempe Signalling Upgrade project.

In November and December, we will be:

- removing redundant overhead wiring and electrical poles
- upgrading and testing electrical cables and signalling infrastructure
- installing signalling structure foundations including minor landscaping
- decommissioning and removing electrical equipment from Undercliffe Substation (Wolli Creek) in preparation for demolition from early 2025
- continuing new substation restoration work, including construction of the turning bay and landscaping.

Please note some of this work is rescheduled activities from September 2024 that you have been previously notified for.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place inside and adjacent to the rail corridor between Arncliffe and Tempe, including the below locations in and around Wolli Creek:

- Spark Lane between Chisholm Street and Mount Olympus Boulevard
- Discovery Point Park
- Corner Chisholm Street and Brodie Spark Drive
- Lusty Street and Tempe site compounds
- Arncliffe Street north of the train station.

Standard construction hours on this project are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

Out of hours work

Due to safety requirements, some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours. This also includes safe delivery of materials to site.

This work will take place between:

- 8pm Tuesday 26 November and 6am Friday 29 November
- 6pm Tuesday 3 December and 2am Tuesday 10 December.

Why we work outside of construction hours

We schedule work outside of standard construction hours to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers. This includes accommodating oversize deliveries on roads.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- an increase in workers and construction vehicles
- increased noise from machinery and equipment, including a mobile crane, hand tools, vacuum trucks, generators, crane truck and other plant, and chainsaw
- temporary traffic changes, signage, and minor detours on the following streets: Chisholm Street, Spark Lane, Brodie Spark Drive, and Lusty Street.

We apologise for any short delays you may experience while our construction vehicles and machines enter and exit the rail corridor under the direction of traffic control. Residential access through local streets will always remain open.

Traffic changes on Spark Lane, Chisholm Street, and Brodie Spark Drive

To safely remove oversized electrical infrastructure components, some traffic changes

are required between 6pm Friday 6 December and 6pm Sunday 8 December, including;

- temporarily closing the road intermittently on Spark Lane, Chisholm Street, and Brodie Spark Drive and some temporary removal of on-street parking
- temporarily restricting access to driveways on Spark Lane between Chisholm Street and Mount Olympus Boulevard, and Brodie Spark Drive, which will have stop/slow access for periods of up to 10 minutes at a time to allow heavy vehicle access.

Traffic control will be in place to safely direct motorists and pedestrians around the work areas. Whilst driveway access will remain open at this area when safe to do so, please plan ahead due to stop/slow traffic flow.

Should access to your property be temporarily impacted during this work, you will be contacted directly ahead of work commencing.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible, including:

- locating equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible
- ensuring lighting towers are directed downwards and away from residents
- compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise.

Ongoing industrial action

Ongoing industrial action is currently taking place in New South Wales, which may lead to changes and last-minute rescheduling of work in the Rail Service Improvement Program. We will make every effort to notify you of changes that occur due to this industrial action. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.
