


Safety improvement work complete on Australia Avenue, Underwood Road and Homebush Bay Drive on/off ramps

Community Notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW has now completed safety improvement work on Homebush Bay Drive, Australia Avenue and Underwood Road at Sydney Olympic Park and Homebush.

The work will improve motorist and pedestrian safety and traffic flow at the Homebush Bay Drive, Australia Avenue and Underwood Road roundabout and at the Homebush Bay Drive on/off ramps, especially during peak periods and special events.

This work was completed to support road safety and traffic flow at this location, in the short term, while the Homebush Bay Drive and Australia Avenue intersection upgrade project design is being finalised.

What work have we completed?

Safety improvement works completed included:

- installation of advanced warning signage for motorists on the Homebush Bay Drive off ramps
- installation of 'roundabout operating' signs
- installation of a pedestrian fence on the western corner of the roundabout
- relocation of the pedestrian crossing on the western corner of the roundabout approximately two to three metres further north.

You may notice our workers in the area in January 2025 carrying out minor finishing works to restore the footpath.

This work will be carried out at night and we do not expect the community to be impacted.

Pedestrian access will be maintained under the direction of traffic controllers.
