
Commuter Car Park Program

February/March 2024









Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is delivering the Beverly Hills Commuter Car Park, with approximately 200 commuter parking spaces to provide you with more convenient access to public transport and to help ease the congestion on our roads.

What is planned?

The Beverly Hills Commuter Car Park on Edgbaston Road will feature:

- A multi-storey commuter car park with approximately 200 commuter parking spaces
- Lift and stairwell access to each level
- CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signage for safety and security
- Provision for future electric vehicle charging
- Park&Ride infrastructure
- Upgrade of existing stairs linking the existing car park to King Georges Road
- Four additional accessible parking spaces located on Tooronga Terrace.

What work are we doing?

During February and March work will include:

- Construction of levels 2, 3 and 4 of the multistorey car park
- Installation of structural steel canopy roof
- Services installation on ground floor of the multistorey carpark
- High voltage electrical works along Hampden Street and Edgbaston Road.

When and where we'll be working

Working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday.

We are working in and around the existing car park at 2-2a Edgbaston Road, as shown on the map over the page.

While we plan for all concreting work to be in working hours, some concreting work may run overtime if we experience unexpected delays. In these instances, concrete pouring will finish before 9pm and finishing works by 10pm.

High voltage electrical work will be undertaken on Hampden Street and Edgbaston Road. This will involve some temporary loss of parking. Alternative parking will be available along other parts of the street. This work is scheduled from late February 2024.

All work is subject to site and weather conditions and may change without further notice.

Managing our impacts

Our work may be noisy at times. We have put measures in place to reduce the impact of this noise, including turning equipment off when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers for trucks used on site.

Changes to parking

The existing Edgbaston Road public car park is closed to commuters during construction of the new commuter car park. The map below will help to identify suitable timed, untimed and disability parking, which provides access to the town centre and railway station.
