Broadway and George Street Bus Lane Improvements

Bus Priority Infrastructure Program

The NSW Government is committed to restoring reliability across the public transport network. The Bus Priority Infrastructure Program is a rolling program that delivers infrastructure improvements to address the reliability and efficiency of bus services in Greater Sydney.

Transport for NSW is taking steps to improve public transport along Broadway and George Street by providing a continuous bus lane on one of the busiest bus corridors in Sydney. Around 33 bus routes serve the three (citybound) bus stops in this area. There is currently no continuous bus lane along this corridor resulting in bus delays. The new bus lane will help to improve bus reliability and efficiency.

What work are we doing?

We will install a new bus lane in the second lane along Broadway and George Street between Mountain Street and Quay Street for buses travelling in the citybound direction.

The bus lane will be in the second lane to make it easier and safer for buses to travel towards Pitt Street as the majority of buses access Pitt Street from George Street.

Key features of the project include:

- Changed bus lane hours with the new bus lane operating from 6am to 8pm on weekdays and 10am to 6pm on weekends
- Retaining the existing kerbside bus lane between Bay Street and Mountain Street in its current position. The hours of this bus lane will be updated to be consistent with the new bus lane.
- Combining the two loading zones on Broadway between Mountain Street and Wattle Street to make one large loading zone. The capacity of loading zone and street parking will remain the same.
- Removing the existing kerbside bus lane between Wattle Street and Harris Street which will be made available for general traffic.

What's next?

Construction is planned to start in early 2025. We will notify the community ahead of construction starting.


