

Changed traffic conditions in Bellata from Friday 8 November

Narrabri to Moree Heavy Duty Pavement November 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Aboriginal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Work is continuing for the Heavy Duty Pavement Upgrade project on the Newell Highway between Narrabri and Moree.

What work are we doing?

Pavement work will be carried out in Bellata on the Newell Highway intersections at Wilga, Oak, North and Temi Streets. During the work, access to the BP truck stop will be maintained.

When and where we'll be working

Work will commence from **Friday 8 November** and will be completed by **Thursday 14 November**, weather permitting. Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Sunday. Please note this work was previously scheduled from 21- 31 October.**

Traffic changes

Access to Oak Street, North Street and Temi Streets will be temporarily closed from **Friday 8 November to Sunday 10 November** and a detour will be in place via **Wilga Street** (see map below).

Access to Wilga Street from the Newell Highway will be temporary closed from **Monday 11 November to Thursday 14 November** and a detour will be in place via **Oak Street or North Street.**

Work on the Newell Highway will be carried out under existing traffic control conditions to keep the work zone safe. This includes reduced speed

limits, lane closures and intermittent stopping.

Ongoing delays of at least 15 minutes should be expected when travelling between Narrabri and Moree. For the latest traffic updates, you can call **132 701**, visit **livetraffic.com** or download the **Live Traffic NSW App**.

Oversize Overmass (OSOM) changes

OSOM vehicles over **six metres wide** may be subject to delays of up to **60 minutes on Friday 8 November and Saturday 9 November..**

What will this mean for you?

You may notice some noise from machinery and equipment during the work.

Temporary road closures and detours may also impact travel time, so please plan ahead, keep to the speed limit and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signage.

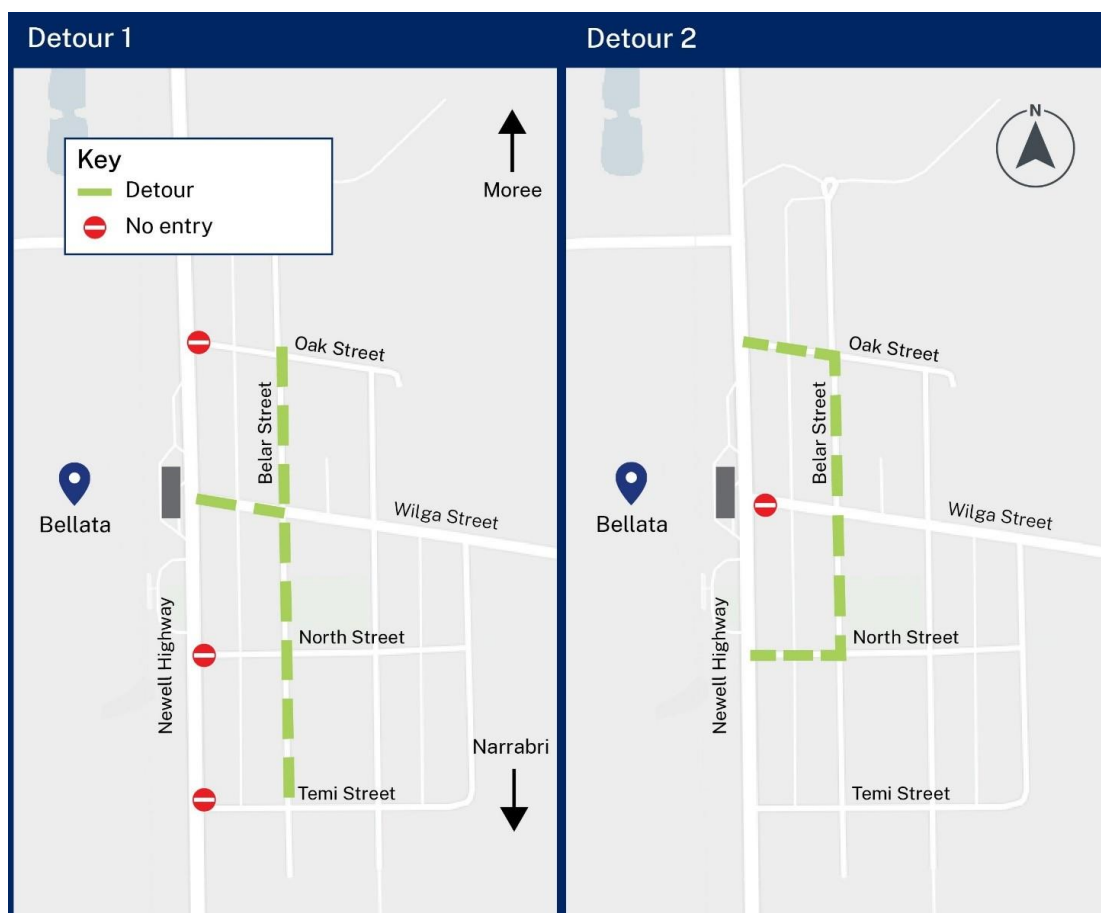
Managing our impacts
