Transport for NSW is carrying out essential road maintenance work in Bathurst.

What work are we doing?

The work will include asphaltting to repair damaged road surface on the Mitchell Highway.

When and where we'll be working

Work will be carried out on the **Mitchell Highway between Boundary Road and Bradwardine Road** from **Sunday 14 July**.

We have included a map to show the work area.

We will be working between **7pm** and **5am** from **Sunday to Friday** nights and expect to complete the work in **six nights**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

What will this mean for you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing louder activities earlier in the evening and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

There will be temporary restrictions to vehicle and pedestrian access to properties within the work area while the work is carried out.

Please ensure vehicles are parked off-street prior to the commencement of work at 7pm each night, for the duration of works.

Please contact us if you have any specific requirements.

Traffic impacts

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

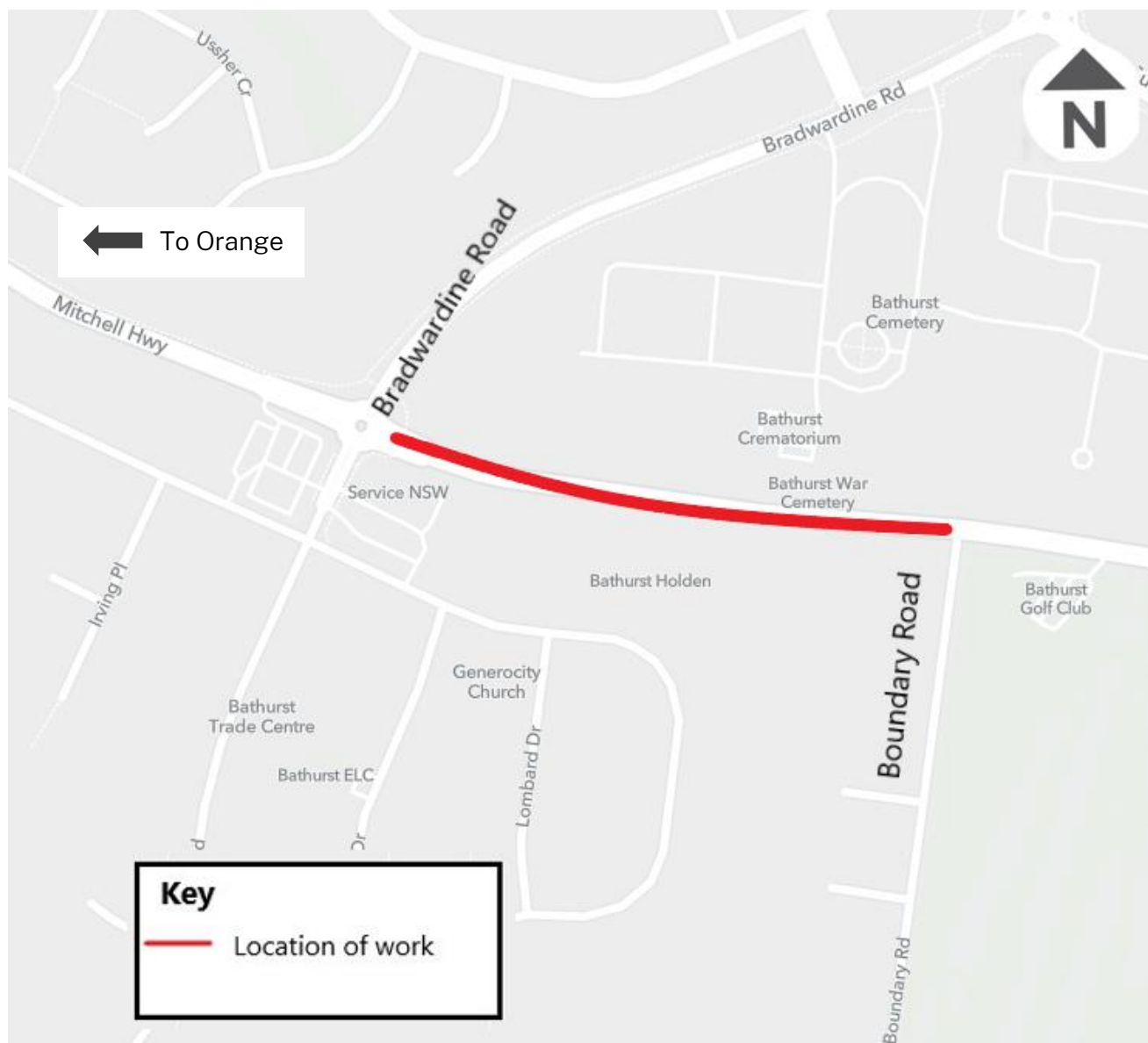
Single lane closures and a 40 km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours which may affect travel times.
