

Changed traffic conditions on Oberon Street in Oberon from Wednesday 26 June

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential road maintenance work in Oberon.

What work are we doing?

The work will include asphalting to repair damaged road surface on Oberon Street.

When we'll be working

Work will be carried out on Oberon Street between Dudley Street and Earl Street.

We have included a map to show the work area.

We will be working between **7am** and **5pm** from **Wednesday 26 June** and expect to complete the work in **three days**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary restrictions to vehicle and pedestrian access to properties within the work area on Oberon Street for around **two hours** while the work is carried out.

Please ensure vehicles are parked off-street prior to the commencement of work at 7am each day, for the duration of works.

Please contact us if you have any specific requirements that need to be met during this time.

Managing our impacts

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.


Single lane closures and a 40 km/h speed limit in place during work hours which may affect travel times.
