

# Nightwork on Great Western Highway on 2 & 3 October

## Coxs River Road Upgrade

September 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges people of the Wiradjuri Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's lead contractor, Ertech is continuing works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

### What work are we doing?

To improve road user safety and to upgrade existing road lighting on the existing Great Western Highway, we will install three new power poles with streetlights in locations shown on the map over the page. These works will involve:

- using an auger to dig holes
- standing up power poles
- anchoring power poles using stays.

In addition to the lighting works, we will trench along Baaners Lane, to allow for future intelligent traffic systems.

**These works are occurring in consultation with Endeavour Energy.**

### When and where we'll be working

We will be working over two nights from **2 October**, between the hours of **7pm and 5am**, weather permitting.

### What will this mean for you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on residents. However, you may notice:

- light from lighting towers
- noise from machinery and equipment
- plant movement in and out of the project site.

### Managing our impacts

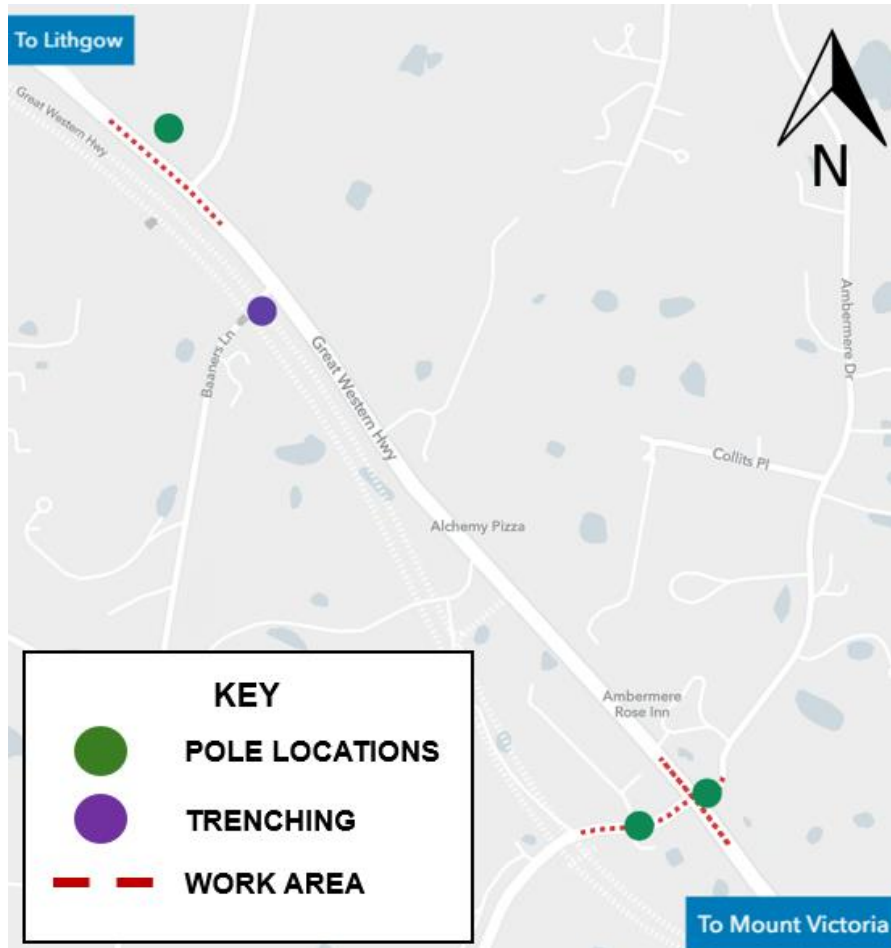
We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- fencing work areas for safety and security
- controlling light spill to ensure it has minimal effect on properties
- reducing our noise as much as possible by working in stages and turning off machinery when not in use
- monitoring and maintaining our environmental controls during and after high rainfall events.
